Hilary Thomas of Lineage Dance will collaborate with Vijay Gupta of the LA Philharmonic and Street Symphony and grows out of the NEA Our Town grant.

AC III	Los Angeles Children's Chorus	\$ 5,000	2016-2017 Community Connections Concerts in Pasadena.
AC III	MUSE/IQUE	\$ 6,500	PERFECT/UNION, is a live music event that is the first of three in the Summer of Sound series focusing on George Gershwin's songwriting partnership with his brother, Ira, and Porgy and Bess. Guest Artists include Shelea Frazier and choreographer Jackie Kopcsak.
AC I	NewTown Pasadena Foundation	\$ 6,448	"Tote your Float and Float your Ride" is a public art performance of 9 wearable, human-powered floats that will take place in Old Pasadena and its environs in one day.
AC II	Parson's Nose	\$ 6,500	Clearly Classic: a production of Shakespeare's Twelfth Night at Lineage Performing Arts Center. .
AC I	Pasadena Community Orchestra	\$ 4,927	Funding for PCO's 2017 Young Artist Competition and Winner's Concert. Funding will support marketing.
AEP	Pasadena Conservatory of Music	\$ 8,500	Young Musicians Program at Jefferson Elementary: 32 weeks of sequential, standards-based music curriculum every year. Program is scheduled to expand this year.
AC I	Pasadena Master Chorale	\$ 6,500	Funding will support staff and artist salaries and composer-mentors for the program "Listening to the Future," which pairs composer-mentors with local youth to develop new choral pieces to be presented at a concert in Pasadena.
AC III	Pasadena Museum of California Art	\$ 5,000	Funding for the exhibition "Interstitial" which brings together 7 art works--yet to be created--by 7 contemporary Los Angeles artists.
AC III	Pasadena Museum of History	\$ 6,500	Funds the development and implementation of the exhibit, "Art in the Street: 25 Years of the Pasadena Chalk Festival"
AC III	Pasadena Playhouse	\$ 7,500	New Generations, an education program that provides a comprehensive theatrical experience to at-risk and underserved youth of Pasadena.
AC I	Pasadena Pro Musica	\$ 7,500	"The Great American Songbook" concert in May 2017 will feature music from the 1920s, 30s and 40s and is the first collaboration between Pasadena Pro Musica and the Blair High School Jazz Band.
AC III	Pasadena Symphony Association	\$ 6,500	Music to the People, a community engagement initiative to provide five (5) Random Acts of Music- interactive music events in unexpected public venues such as libraries, community centers, banks, shopping malls and schools featuring local , professional musicians.
AC II	Side Street Projects	\$ 6,500	Funding will support a series of six "Skill Share" workshops to build head and hand skills for artists and teaching artists.
