CANDIDATE NOMINATION FILING PERIOD OPENS

- 7/13/2020 Monday, July 13, 2020: Official Nomination Papers for Board of Education, Districts 2, 4, and 6 become available for issuance in the Pasadena City Clerk's Office, 100 North Garfield Avenue, Room S228, Pasadena. During the period of **July 13, 2020 through August 7, 2020**, both days included, candidates for the Board of Education in Geographic Sub-Districts 2, 4, or 6 may circulate nomination petitions to gather signatures from registered voters that reside in the geographic sub-district of the office sought.
- 7/13/2020 - 8/07/2020 Due to COVID-19 concerns and safety protocols, candidate workshops will be limited to no more than 5 candidates at a time. For more information, or to register for a limited-participant candidate workshop, please contact the Pasadena City Clerk's Office at (626) 744-4124, beginning Monday, July 6, 2020.
- 8/07/2020 The deadline for the submittal of Candidate Statements for the Office of Mayor closes on Friday, August 7, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.
- 7/31/2020 Semi-Annual Campaign Statement due for the period 1/1/2020 - 6/30/2020 if filing obligations were incurred during this period.
- 8/05/2020 - 11/03/2020 Large Contribution and Expenditure Reporting Period (90 Days Prior to Election) – Filing deadline is within 24 hours of receiving contributions of \$1,000 or more from a single source

CANDIDATE NOMINATION FILING PERIOD CLOSSES

- 8/07/2020 The Nomination Period for all of the above offices (where the incumbent files nomination papers) closes on Friday, August 7, 2020, at 5:00 p.m.
- 8/12/2020 Extended Nomination Period: If an incumbent candidate for the Board of Education in Districts 2, 4, or 6 does not file nomination papers, the nomination period is extended to Wednesday, August 12, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., for only that office and for only candidates other than the incumbent.
- 9/08/2020 - 10/20/2020 Filing period for write-in candidates.

- 9/24/2020 First Pre-Election Campaign Statement due for the period 7/1/2020 - 9/19/2020.
- 10/05/2020 - Voters may request vote by mail ballots. October 5, 2020 is the first day
10/27/2020 vote by mail ballots may be issued by the County. Voters may request vote by mail ballots through October 27, 2020. **Important:** Due to actions taken by Governor Gavin Newsom and the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors in response to COVID-19, it is anticipated that every registered voter in Los Angeles County will receive a Vote by Mail ballot. - 10/19/2020 Last day to register to vote. Same day voter registration is available at any Vote Center location in the County of Los Angeles.
- 10/22/2020 Second Pre-Election Campaign Statement due for the period 9/20/2020 - 10/17/2020.
- 10/24/2020 - Vote Center Voting (in-person) will be available at designated locations
11/03/2020 weekdays and weekends at any Vote Center located in the County of Los Angeles beginning Saturday, October 24, 2020 and continuing through Election Day, November 3, 2020. **Important:** Due to actions taken by Governor Gavin Newsom and the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors in response to COVID-19, it is anticipated that every registered voter in Los Angeles County will receive a Vote by Mail ballot. - 10/27/2020 Last day applications for vote by mail ballots may be received by the County Registrar of Voters. (Elections Code 3001)
- 11/03/2020 ELECTION DAY** - Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- 12/07/2020 General Election certified results presented to the City Council and the Board of Education.

Board of Education: The candidate receiving the highest number of votes in the general election for each geographic sub-district shall be deemed elected for that office, without any run-off election. In the case of a tie vote, the Board of Education shall summon the candidates affected to appear at a time and place designated by the Board and shall at that time and place determine the tie by lot. (Pasadena Charter Section 706)
