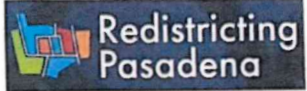

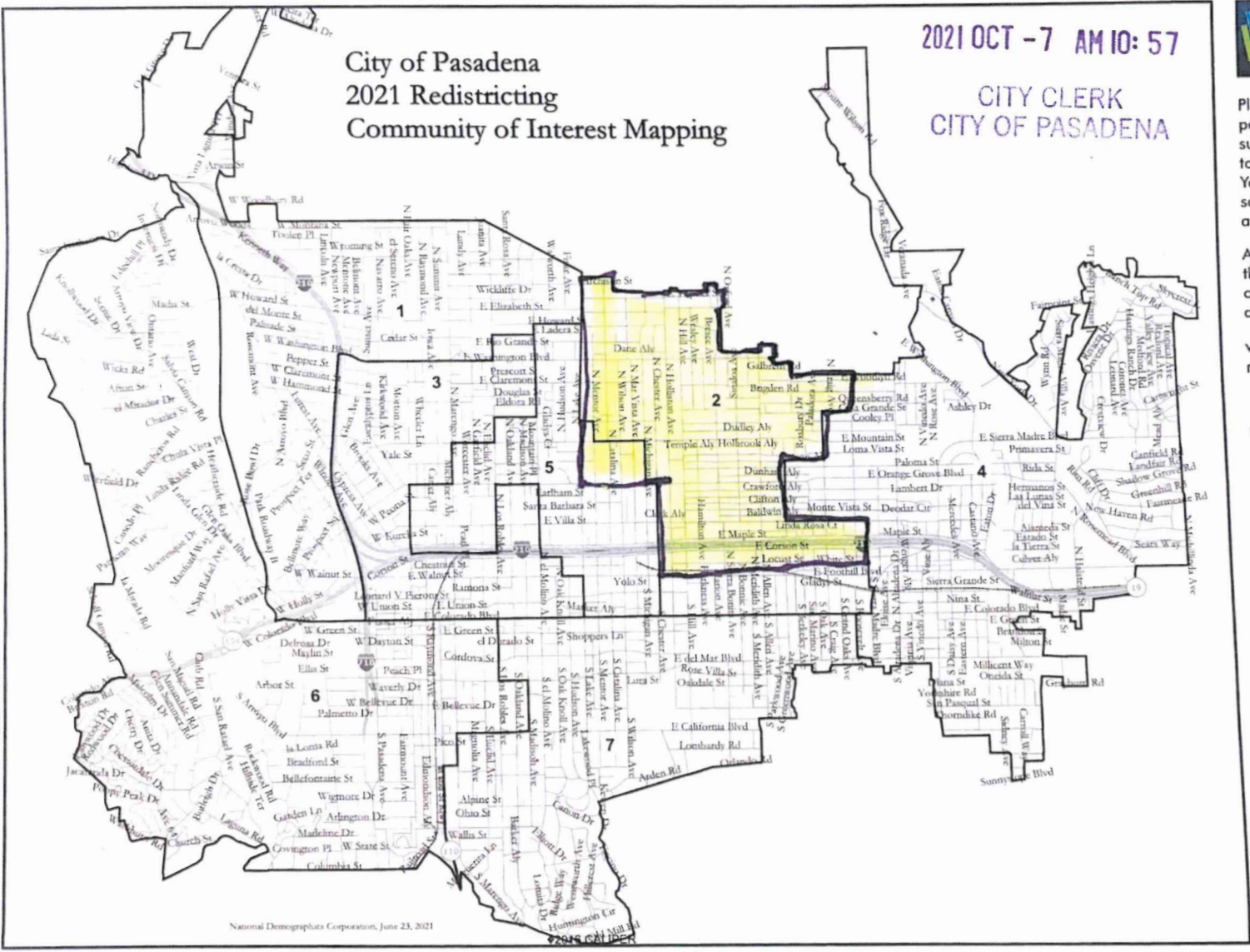

Tell the City About Your Community of Interest

Every ten years, cities with districts must conduct a redistricting process to ensure the proper balance of populations between all districts. The completion of the 2020 Census prompted the process to take place in Pasadena in 2021. The Pasadena City Council formed a Redistricting Task Force to focus on this important effort, review changes in populations and demographics in the City, and recommend a redistricting plan to the City Council.

As part of this effort, the Task Force is asking members of the public to submit information about communities of interest in the City. A "community of interest" is a population that shares common social or economic interests that should be included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation.
