Dear Chair Farhat and Task Force Members,

At the recent Task Force Meeting on October 9th, I spoke at the meeting, so thank you for listening.

From that meeting, I felt that the Redistricting member from district 2 gave me the impression of not really being thoughtful about the equity of other districts such as 1, 3, 5. She seemed only to care about the equity for district 2 and suggested at the end of the meeting that the consultants study the taking of more population for district 2 from districts 4 and 7. It was not in the best interest of the redistricting process.

Most of the redistricting task force members want to minimize the population changes for less disruption in the districts by using the 10% deviation map, and a simple solution is to just move the population from district 6 to district 7 and district 5. If district 5 is too difficult to consider, then use district 3.

The drawing of more maps is needed with equal respect for all districts.
