NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Pasadena General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Pasadena on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for the following two City Ballot Measures:

<b>Pasadena Infrastructure/Community Essential Services Protection Measure</b> Shall an ordinance be adopted to maintain essential City of Pasadena services such as fire, police, paramedics, emergency service/response times; keep fire stations open; improve neighborhood and school safety; repair streets/sidewalks; address homelessness; maintain after-school programs/senior services, and other general fund services, by establishing a $\frac{3}{4}\%$ sales tax providing approximately \$21,000,000 annually until ended by voters; requiring audits and all funds locally controlled?	<b>YES</b>
