1. **PWP Announces a Special Summer Promotion – Receive Double the L2L Greywater Program Voucher:**

During periods of high heat, landscapes may require more water. While outdoor watering is now permitted up to three days a week, Pasadena Water and Power (“PWP”) continues to promote *Conservation as a Way of Life* and encourages reduced water consumption whenever possible. As a special summer promotion, PWP has doubled the value of its L2L Greywater Program (“program”) voucher until September 30, 2017. Now at \$160, the voucher will cover the majority of the cost of system parts.

In order to participate in the program, residents must first attend an in-depth training workshop, where they can determine if their home is right for a greywater system. The free workshop will also provide information on how to properly design and install an L2L greywater system, how to measure a home’s greywater output, and which soaps and detergents are “greywater friendly”. Attendees will receive a voucher to be used towards the cost of system parts, redeemable at Landscape Warehouse in Pasadena. The program also offers no-cost installation of an L2L greywater system for income-qualified customers enrolled in PWP’s Electric Utility Assistance Program.

According to Gurcharan Bawa, General Manager of Water & Power, over 50% of a home’s water use is for irrigation. Greywater – water that is collected from showers, washing machines, and bathroom sinks and then used to irrigate landscapes – can be a valuable conservation tool, especially during the summer when there is a greater demand for potable water.

The next program workshop is scheduled for Saturday, May 20 from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. at Villa-Parke Community Center (363 E Villa St.). To learn more about the L2L Greywater Program, visit: <http://www.PWPweb.com/Greywater>.

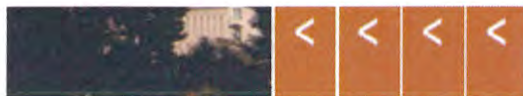
