1. May is Water Awareness Month – Embrace the Value of Our Precious Resource:

Water Awareness Month was established in 1989 to encourage conservation and highlight the value of reliable, high-quality water. Gurcharan Bawa, General Manager of Water and Power announces that the department will celebrate the month of May by engaging with a variety of community groups throughout Pasadena and educating them about the importance of our most precious resource.

To kick off Water Awareness Month, PWP is partnering with the City of Pasadena Public Health Department for Rethink Your Drink Day on Wednesday, May 8 at La Pintaresca Library and Park. The event is a statewide initiative to encourage the public to switch from sugary drinks to healthy drinking water. At the event, PWP and the Public Health Department will promote drinking great-tasting Pasadena tap water with a variety of family-friendly activities and giveaways. PWP will also be unveiling a new hydration station at La Pintaresca Park, which will provide a convenient place to refill reusable water bottles with healthy drinking water. Over the next few months, more hydration stations will be installed at Villa Parke, Jackie Robinson Park, and other community center locations in Pasadena. PWP is committed to providing the community with access to convenient, healthy hydration sources that help to protect local water. By using hydration stations and reusable bottles, Pasadena residents are also helping to reduce the plastic waste that enters into our local Arroyo Seco stream.

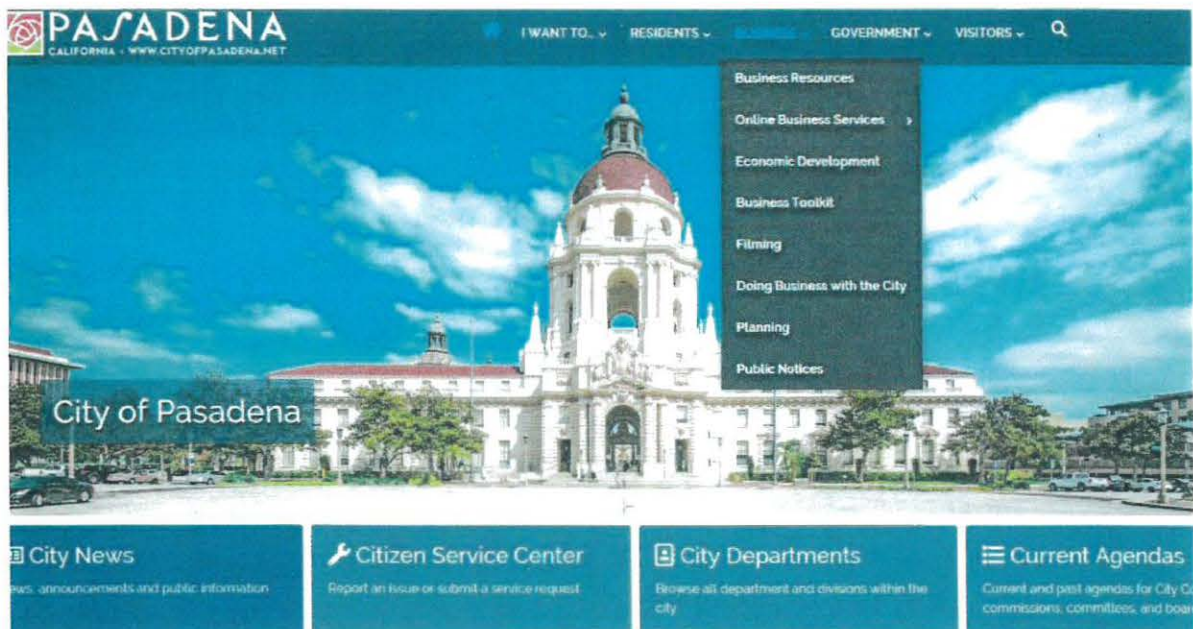

Notice of Public Hearing to Amend Single-Family Residential Standards (Mansionization)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed project consists of Zoning Code amendments responding to community concerns related to single-family residential development perceived to be out of scale or character with existing neighborhoods. The proposed amendments would revise existing development standards related to single-family dwellings within the RS-1, RS-2, RS-4, and RS-6 zones.

PROJECT LOCATION: Citywide

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The Planning Commission will consider whether adoption of the proposed Zoning Code amendments are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act under Class 5 §15305 – Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations and Class 8 §15308 - Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment. Class 5 consists of minor alterations in land use limitations in areas with an average slope of less than 20%, which do not result in any changes in land use or density. Class 8 consists of action taken by regulatory agencies, as authorized by state and local ordinance, to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of the environment where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the environment.

APPROVALS NEEDED: The Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing and consider the proposed CEQA exemption and code amendments on May 22, 2019. The Planning Commission will forward its recommendation to the City Council. The City Council will make a final decision on the CEQA exemption and proposed amendments at a separately-noticed public hearing.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to receive input from the public and provide comments on proposed revisions to Section 17.22 of the Pasadena Municipal Code, pertaining to the RS-1, RS-2, RS-4, and RS-6 single-family residential zones.
