With six Gold Line stations operating in Pasadena, we have a steady stream of customers from throughout the Southland using Pasadena Transit as their first and last mile connection. 15 % of Pasadena Transit ridership comes from as far as Corona, Huntington Beach, West Hollywood, Upland and Sun Valley.
