1. Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department Wins Southern California Municipal Athletics Federation Service Awards:

Brenda Harvey-Williams, Director of the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department is proud to announce the department has recently received a Service Award and Innovative Sports Programming Recognition from the Southern California Municipal Athletics Federation (SCMAF). Service Awards are "...given for an exceptional contribution to the Federation by an Active or Associate Member for an effort or activity during the past year, or for outstanding service to the Federation." Recreation Coordinator John Chacon received a service award in recognition of the 2019 5th/6th grade Flag Football Tournament hosted in Pasadena on December 14 and 15, 2019. Pasadena was crowned tournament champion when it defeated Bakersfield 12-0 in the championship game and this team went on to become Southern California 5th/6th Grade Champions.



Pasadena was also awarded "Innovative Sports Programming Recognition" in 2020 for its work in providing safe and innovative outdoor recreation programs during a pandemic. The flag football training program for youth, was celebrated for providing safe, fun, and inclusive outdoor trainings while adhering to COVID-19 protocols and guidelines. The football training program was held at Robinson Park during the fall 2020 session from September 28 through November 19.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT THIS HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE AT A MEETING HELD PURSUANT TO GOVERNOR GAVIN NEWSOM'S EXECUTIVE ORDER N-29-20 SOLELY BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Pursuant to Pasadena Municipal Code ("PMC") Section 17.66.080, and Section 23 of Development Agreement No. 30469, the approved and executed Development Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties. The purpose of the hearing is to consider amendments proposed by the applicant after completion of a periodic review process previously held pursuant to Section 17.66.070. Development Agreement No. 30469 was originally executed on April 27, 2015 between the City of Pasadena and PPF OFF 100 West Walnut Lincoln Properties for the project at 10 West Walnut Avenue.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The Council will be asked to consider whether the proposed action is exempt from CEQA per section 15061(b)(3), the Common Sense Exemption (formerly the General Rule).
