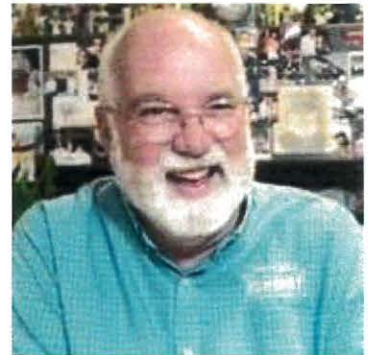

One City, One Story is designed to broaden and deepen an appreciation of reading and literature and to promote tolerance and understanding of differing points of view by recommending a compelling book that engages the community in conversation. Tattoos on the Heart is a series of parables about kinship and redemption from pastor, activist and renowned speaker Father Gregory Boyle. In this, his debut book, he distills his experience working with gang members into a breathtaking series of stories inspired by faith. *Tattoos on the Heart* reminds us that no life is less valuable than another.

From giant, tattooed Cesar, shopping at JC Penney fresh out of prison, we learn how to feel worthy of God’s love. From 10-year-old Pipi, we learn the importance of being known and acknowledged. From Lulu, we come to understand the kind of patience necessary to rescue someone from the dark—as Father Boyle phrases it, we can only shine a flashlight on a light switch in a darkened room. This is a motivating look at how to remain faithful in spite of failure, how to meet the world with a loving heart, and how to conquer shame with boundless, restorative love.

Founder of Homeboy Industries, the largest gang intervention, rehabilitation and re-entry program in the world, Father Boyle has dedicated his life to helping the most marginalized individuals find a place in

society. In a moving example of unconditional love in difficult times, the Jesuit priest and bestselling author of *Tattoos on the Heart* and *Barking to the Choir: The Power of Radical Kinship* shares what three decades of working with gang members in Los Angeles have taught him about faith, compassion and the enduring power of kinship.

Father Boyle has received the California Peace Prize and has been inducted into the California Hall of Fame. In 2014, President Obama named Father Boyle a *Champion of Change*. He was named the 2016 Humanitarian of the Year by the James Beard Foundation, a national culinary-arts organization, and he received the University of Notre Dame's 2017 Laetare Medal, the oldest honor given to American Catholics. Currently, he serves as a committee member of California Governor Gavin Newsom's Economic and Job Recovery Task Force as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In 2020, Homeboy Industries received the Conrad N. Hilton Humanitarian Prize of \$2.5 million, given to non-profits that have made "extraordinary contributions" toward alleviating human suffering.

General work description: The Villa Parke Community Center – Renovation and Addition includes renovations to the existing auditorium, roof, hallway, locker rooms, pool and pool equipment room, weight room, boxing room, and addition to the east courtyard. The Work includes, but is not limited to, enclosing an existing courtyard and converting it into a lobby, installation of new fixtures and flooring, demolition of partitions, repair/patch ceiling, repair/replacement of roofing, demolition of concrete pads, installation of a new concrete deck, pool fixtures, and bleachers, replacement of existing pool equipment, addition of new mechanical and electrical systems for enclosed courtyard, retrofit/upgrades to existing drainage, and hazardous materials abatement.

Length of contract: 160 working days

The estimated cost of the project: \$ 3,000,000

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting is scheduled for **March 31, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.** at Villa Parke Community Center located at 363 E. Villa Street, Pasadena, CA 91101. This meeting is to answer any questions regarding the project plans and specifications, and review site conditions. Each attendee is required to follow COVID-19 safety protocols and bring their own personal protective equipment (PPE), including but not limited to face masks, and maintain a minimum social distance of 6 feet from others. Attendees who do not have their own PPE will not be allowed in the meeting.

ATTENDANCE IS NON-MANDATORY

Deadline for Bidder Request for Information and/or Equal Substitution Request must be submitted to the Agency Representative by **April 5, 2021, 2:00 p.m.** All RFIs and/or Substitution request must be submitted via e-mail to Tiffany Chen, email: tchen@cityofpasadena.net

Each Bidder must hold an active **Class A or B** License with the State of California Contractors License Board and at the time of bid submission, except as to joint venture Bidders, who shall be licensed as provided in Business and Professions Code §§ 7029.1 and 7028.15(c). The Bidder or a listed Subcontractor must also hold an active **Class C-53** License and be certified by the California Department of Public Health for lead-paint abatement.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1770 to 1782 of the California Labor Code, the California Department of Industrial Relations has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages in the county in which work is to be done. A copy of the general prevailing rate of wages is on file with the City Engineer and is available for inspection and reference during regular business hours.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of this public works project unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of Labor Code Section 1771.1 for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The Contractor must post job site notices prescribed by regulation (See e.g. 8 Cal. Code Reg. Section 16451(d).

Contractors and Subcontractors must furnish electronic certified payroll records directly to the California Labor Commissioner (aka Division of Labor Standards Enforcement).

All bids must be accompanied by bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid price, in the form of a redeemable or callable electronic surety bond, meeting City requirements.
