1. Pasadena Transit Service Change Effective August 1, 2021:

Laura Rubio-Cornejo, Director of Transportation, announces the implementation of a service change for Pasadena Transit coming on August 1, 2021. In accordance with Pasadena Health Department, Los Angeles County and State guidelines, this service change will help meet ridership demands, including scheduling changes that correspond with the new PUSD high school start times. Frequencies beginning August 1 will be:

- Route 10: No change (already running pre-COVID frequencies)
- Route 20 weekday: Every 16-20 minutes
- Route 20 Sat. & Sun: Minor adjustments
- Route 31/32 weekday & Saturday: Minor adjustments
- Route 40 weekday: Minor adjustments
- Route 51 weekday: Added service between 6:30 a.m. – 8 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.
- Route 52: Added 3 daily trips

Route 60 continues to be temporarily suspended.

Face coverings are still required while on board a Pasadena Transit vehicle.

Fare charging resumed on Pasadena Transit and Dial-A-Ride on April 12, 2021. Measures put in place to protect riders and bus operators due to COVID include:

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- Disinfecting high touch surfaces on buses daily
- Enhanced nightly disinfecting of every bus surface from floor to ceiling
- Providing single use masks on the buses for riders
- Hand sanitizing dispensers on every bus

Zoning Code Amendment to Cannabis Business Regulations

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT THIS HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE SOLELY BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed project is an amendment to the City's existing Cannabis Business regulations (Section 17.50.066 of the Zoning Code and other applicable sections) to modify the location requirements to allow up to three cannabis retailers per council district and also decrease the distance between cannabis retailers from 1,000 feet to 450 feet. This code amendment will not change the citywide limit of more than six commercial cannabis retailers.

PROJECT LOCATION: All commercial and industrial zoned properties where cannabis retail uses can be permitted pursuant to Section 17.50.066 of the Zoning Code.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City Council will be asked to consider whether the the proposed action is exempt from the CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment, and whether the proposed Zoning Code Amendment is also exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 "Existing Facilities" (Class 1). Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination.

APPROVALS NEEDED: The City Council will conduct a public hearing and consider the proposed amendment and Categorical Exemptions on August 9, 2021. Substantially similar amendments were considered by the Planning Commission on November 13, 2019. The Planning Commission did not recommend approval of the amendments. The amendments were then presented to the Council on November 25, 2019 and staff was directed to work through Ed-Tech on proposed changes before presenting the changes to City Council.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council will hold a public hearing to receive input from the public and provide comments on proposed amendments to the Pasadena Municipal Code, pertaining to cannabis businesses regulations.
