1. **Pasadena Public Library Celebrates 2022 One City, One Story Summer Edition with a Series of Book Discussions:**

The One City, One Story Summer Edition celebration kicked off in June with a presentation of *Stealing Home, Los Angeles, the Dodgers and the Lives Caught in Between* by author Eric Nusbaum.

Tim McDonald, Acting Director of Libraries and Information Services, reports the program continues throughout July with a series of book discussions and author talks. Each event features a different book that expands upon this summer's One City, One Story themes of baseball, diversity, and legacy.

This year marks the 20th anniversary of One City, One Story at the Pasadena Public Library. One City, One Story encourages community fellowship through the shared experience of reading. Each selection shares the common goal: engaging our diverse community in meaningful conversations that promote tolerance and understanding of different points of view.

In his book, *My 30 Years in Dodger Blue*, Fred Claire takes you through his 30 years with the Los Angeles Dodgers, from the 1988 championship victory to the turmoil of the 1998 Fox purchase. Claire reveals his personal perspective on the events that made headlines, as well as those that didn't. While *Extra Innings: Fred Claire's Journey to City of Hope and Finding a World Championship Team*, recalls Claire's remarkable baseball career, it also recounts the miraculous story of his cancer fight at City of Hope. 2. Pasadena Water and Power Staff Achieves Success at 2022 Lineman's Rodeo:

Jeffrey Kightlinger, Interim General Manager of Water and Power, reports that each year the Los Angeles Water and Power Department and IBEW Local 18 host an annual competition called the Lineman's Rodeo. Linemen and Apprentice Linemen from across Southern California compete at the rodeo to demonstrate their skills. Events include pole climbs, hurt-man rescues, live-line tool expertise, and more. The rodeo, in addition to being an opportunity to showcase complex abilities, is also a time to recognize the oftentimes dangerous work that linemen perform every day. On Saturday, May 14, 2022, Pasadena Water and Power's ("PWP") Transmission and Distribution Team ("T&D") competed and received awards in multiple categories.

Trevor Ingram, Apprentice Electrical Distribution Mechanic, received first-place for the Speed Climb event. Juvenal Magana-Torres, also an Apprentice Electrical Distribution Mechanic, received second-place for the Hurt-Man Rescue event and third-place for the Obstacle Course event. Including Ingram and Magana, an additional three PWP employees from the T&D Team will be traveling to Kansas City in October to compete at the International Lineman's Rodeo. This international event attracts the best linemen from around the world to compete, and has been hosting utility professionals for more than 30 years.

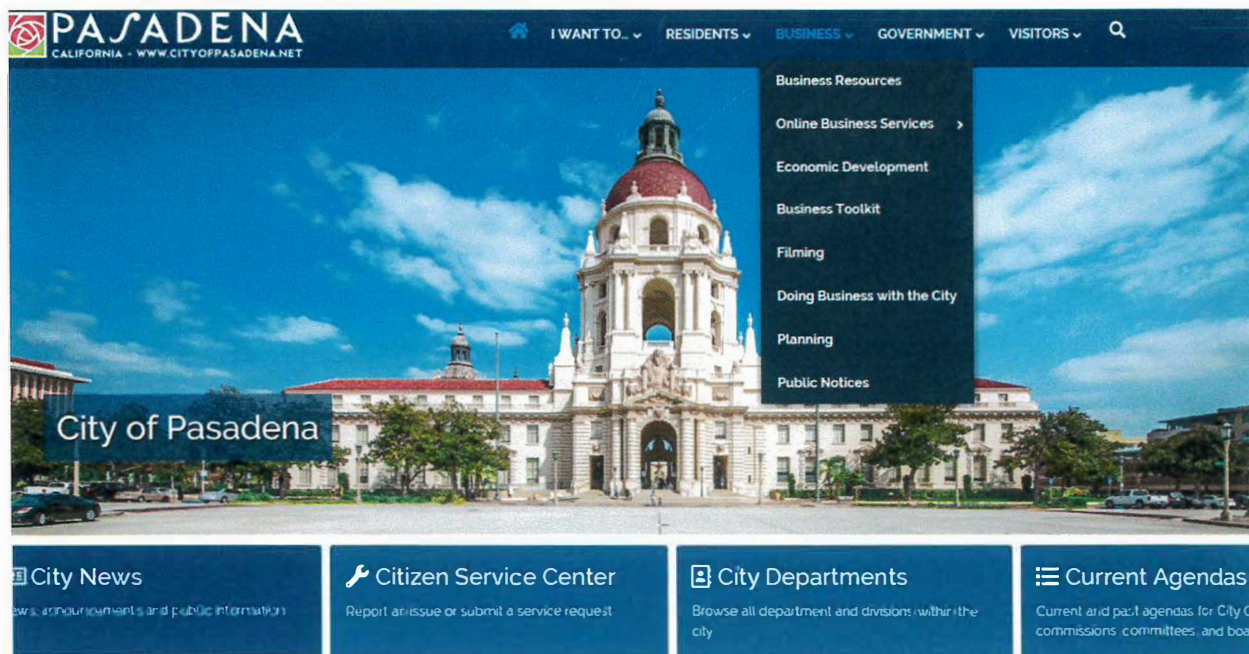
