2. **Foothill Freeway (I-210) On-and Off-Ramp Closures Scheduled in Pasadena:**

The California Department of Transportation (“Caltrans”) has announced the scheduled closures of on-and off-ramps and some adjoining street lanes along I-210 in Pasadena to upgrade curb ramps, install Accessible Pedestrian Signal (“APS”) systems and pedestrian countdown timers and re-stripe crosswalks to conform to current Americans With Disabilities Act (“ADA”) standards. 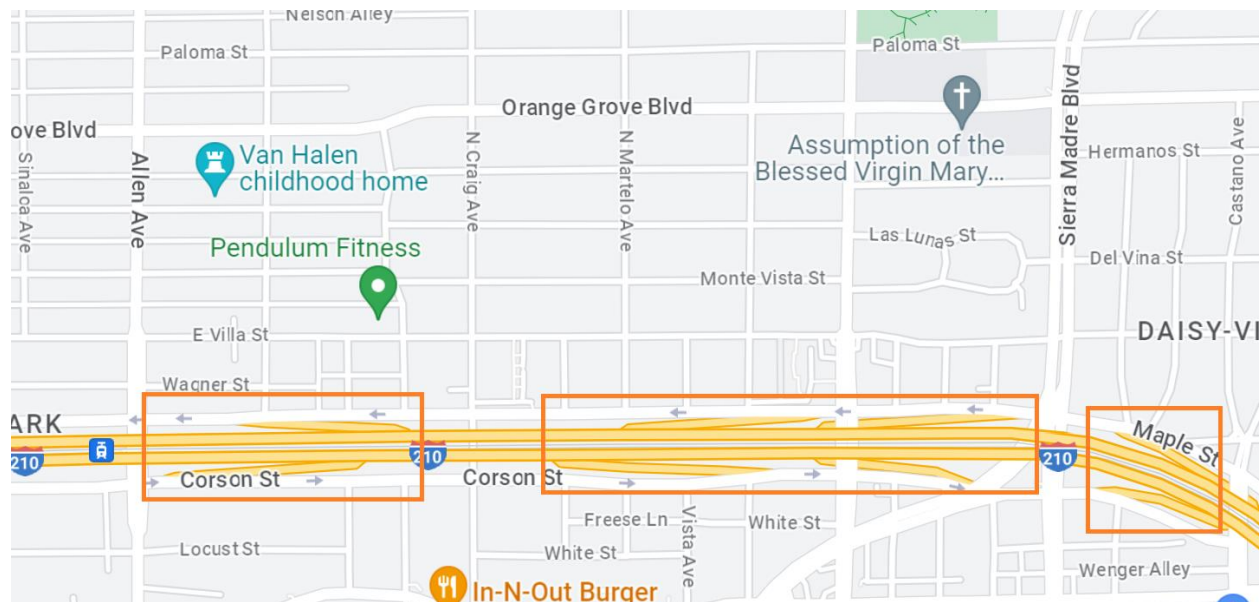

I-210 On- and Off-Ramp Closures Scheduled in Pasadena

Pasadena- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the scheduled closures of on- and off-ramps and some adjoining street lanes along I-210 in Pasadena to upgrade curb ramps, install Accessible Pedestrian Signal (APS) systems and pedestrian countdown timers and re-stripe crosswalks to conform to current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. The closures are subject to change and are scheduled as follows:

Tuesday, Oct. 24 through Friday, Oct. 27 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.:

On I-210 full or partial ramp closures and adjacent street lane closures should be expected at eastbound and westbound ramps at Allen Avenue and Alta Dena Drive; the eastbound San Gabriel Boulevard on-ramp; and the westbound Sierra Madre Boulevard/San Gabriel Boulevard off-ramp.
