- 3. Review and comment on the following tops as part of the General Plan Mobility Element Update:**

***Pasadena ARTS Service Overview**

An information report was provided to TAC with an overview of how the Pasadena Area Rapid Transit System (ARTS) service has developed and changed during the past sixteen years. Also reviewed were the ARTS restructuring Plan and the recent changes in the service structure due to changing economics. The Commissioners were given an opportunity to ask questions and make comments.

***Pasadena ARTS Short Range Transit Plan Update**

An overview was given on what the background of the Short Range Transit Plan Update (SRTP) is and the process. Also discussed were developed options for the future including review of recommendations with Working Groups, developing

priorities, reviewing recommendations with the TAC SRTP Ad Hoc Committee and then presenting the recommendations to TAC. The Commissioners were given an opportunity to ask questions and make comments.

***Pasadena Street Types Update**

An overview was given regarding the City Council workshop that was held on street classification. The classification system under consideration includes context, function and overlays. A series of focus groups with residents and business owners was held. Input was given on the street classification efforts. The input from those meetings will be used to further communicate more effectively the street classification process during the General Plan update as well as to refine the technical aspects of the system proposed by the consultants.
