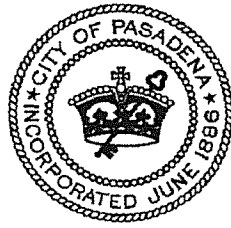

C. Transportation Impact Review Guidelines – Part 1 (Information only)

Mr. Bagheri presented an overview of the proposed *Transportation Impact Review Guidelines – Part 1*. The proposed guidelines assess the impacts of development projects on all modes of travel that use the street system (pedestrians, bicycles, transit and other vehicles) and adopt the Multi Modal Level of Service (MMLOS) methodology for evaluating the quality of service on all modes of travel.

Commission Comments

- Chair Higginbotham suggested the current thresholds for segment impacts be re-examined.
- Commissioner Trout noted that MMLOS impacts may be difficult to ascertain given how inter-related all modes are.
- Commissioner Yonashiro suggested that staff supply Council better information with respect to the findings of traffic impacts.

- Chair Higginbotham noted that changes on S. Fair Oaks Avenue in South Pasadena may cause spill over traffic into adjacent neighborhoods. Mr. Dock noted that staff would review and assess the possible impacts of these changes.
- Chair Higginbotham announced that Commissioner Yonashiro had been recommended to serve as the TAC representative on the Design Commission. The appointment is pending Council approval.
- Chair Higginbotham noted that the revised TAC Rules and Regulations would be presented to Council in the near future.
- Chair Higginbotham encouraged the Commission to review the proposed trip generation charts in the General Plan/Mobility Element alternatives. In addition, Commissioner Yonashiro encouraged the Commission to review the population growth charts produced through the General Plan charettes. Mr.

Yamarone noted that the aforementioned data would be analyzed by the *Travel Demand Model Forecast*.

- Chair Higginbotham noted that City reached an agreement on the IDS project.
