RE: Staff Activities Update

A. Council Committee Activity

- The proposed Pasadena Complete Streets Plan was presented to the Municipal Services Committee on April 9, 2013. The Committee directed staff to bring this item to TAC and the Planning Commission for any further review or comment, and return to the MSC for bringing the item to the City Council for adoption.
- The City Manager's recommended FY 2014 Capital Improvement Program is scheduled to be presented to a joint meeting of the Finance Committee and City Council on Monday April 29, 2013.

B. SR-710 North EIR/EIS

The next meeting of the Metro's Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) for SR-710 EIR/EIS is scheduled for Wednesday, April 24, 2013 at 9:30 AM at Metro headquarters. The purpose of the TAC is to inform affected agencies and/or jurisdictions about the progress of the State Route 710 EIR/EIS contract and key milestones, and to solicit input on a wide range of planning and technical issues that may arise during the development of the EIR/EIS. C. Pasadena Bikeshare

The Department of Transportation will release in early May a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to gather credentials from existing bikeshare vendors and/or operators in an effort to launch a bikeshare program in Pasadena. The RFQ proposes a phased program rollout beginning with a Pilot program focused on Central Pasadena (Old Pasadena to Pasadena City College) and the Gold Line stations which would provide

300 bicycles distributed between 30 bikeshare kiosks. The goal is to provide convenient and affordable non-auto travel options for residents, visitors and workers.

D. Parking Management System

Staff from Transportation, Finance and Information Technology are on schedule with the implementation of a new web-based management system for parking permits and citations. The system will streamline the current paper-based processes for parking permits and citation processing.
