Background

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- Annual Report Card established after 2004 General Plan Mobility Element
- Data collected since 2006
- Traffic Counts, Travel Time & Speed Studies, ARTS annual ridership report



Traffic Counts

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- Average Daily Traffic (ADT) represents 24-hour counts at specified mid-block locations conducted on either a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday.

Factors that affect Travel Times

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- Construction (Lane closures or blockage)
- Road Diets
- Traffic Signal Synchronization
- Increase in traffic volumes
