OLD PASADENA PARKING METER ZONE ADVISORY COMMISSION

Year End Report of Accomplishments: July 1, 2012 – June 30, 2013

PURPOSE:

The Old Pasadena Parking Meter Zone Advisory Commission was formed in 1993, as part of the Parking Meter Installation Program in the Old Pasadena area. The purpose of the commission is to:

1. Recommend to City Council priority expenditures of net revenues from parking meters within the Old Pasadena Parking Meter Zone for streetscape and parking related expenditures within the Zone, and,
2. Study and examine any other parking related issues referred to it by the City Council or by the Director of Transportation which may include, but without limitation, proposed changes and amendments to parking meter rates.
