Violation of the Pasadena Municipal Code:

General penalty – Pasadena Municipal Code Section 1.24.10(A):

“No person shall violate or fail to comply with any provision or requirement of this code. Any person who violates or fails to comply with any provision or requirement of this code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, unless (1) such a violation or failure is designated as an infraction or is subsequently prosecuted as an infraction, in which case such person is guilty of an infraction; or (2) such a violation or failure is prosecuted as a civil administrative action pursuant to Chapter 1.25 or Chapter 1.26 of this title.”

14.50.040(1)(30) Prohibited activities or conditions.

“It is declared unlawful and a public nuisance for any person owning, leasing, occupying, or having charge or possession of any property in this city to maintain such property, regardless of whether such property contains a conforming or legal nonconforming use or structure, in a manner that any of the following conditions or activities are found to exist thereon: [1] The accumulation of dirt, litter, junk, salvage materials, lumber or other debris visible from a street, sidewalk, alley or neighboring property, or verified through other lawful means, [30] Storage of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, unregistered or inoperative automobile, trailer, camper, recreational vehicle, boat or other such vehicles or equipment on residential property.”

Recommended Commission Corrective Action:

The Commission orders James and Carmen Mitchell to take the following corrective actions within thirty (30) calendar days from the mailing date of the Order of the Code Enforcement Commission:

1. Make the Chevrolet pickup truck, California license plate number 39540E, fully operable, registered and capable of being lawfully driven on a public roadway, or lawfully store the vehicle within a garage or other lawfully constructed storage structure on site, or remove the vehicle from the subject property.
2. Remove from the open yard area and the open front porch all miscellaneous junk and debris which includes but is not limited to such things as broken/discarded bricks, plywood, buckets, crates, cardboard boxes, plastic boxes, shelving, jack stands, furniture, television set, and other household items. All items must be stored either in the residence, in a lawfully constructed garage or other storage structure, or moved off site.

Upon meeting the above referenced conditions and complying with the applicable sections of the Pasadena Municipal Code, James or Carmen Mitchell or an authorized representative thereof shall contact Code Compliance Manager Jon Pollard at (626) 744-6831, to schedule a re-inspection of the property


