






WORK PLAN: JULY 1, 2014 TO JUNE 30, 2015

1. **Water and Power Issues:**
 - a. Continue to evaluate and make recommendations to the City Council on upcoming issues and policies.
 - b. Participate in the update of the Power Integrated Resource Plan.
2. **General Plan Update:** Provide input to the City Council, as appropriate, related to the General Plan Land Use and Mobility Element updates.
3. **Greenhouse Gas:** Review and provide input in the development of the Climate Action Plan.
4. **Zero Waste:**
 - a. Provide input to the City Council on development of the Zero Waste Strategic Plan.
 - b. Research and collaborate with other municipalities on a Polystyrene Ban.
 - c. Continue to monitor the implementation of the Plastic Bag Ban.
 - d. Monitor the City's efforts in multi-family residential recycling.
 - e. Monitor the City's efforts in the Construction Waste & Recycling Ordinance.
5. **City Green Policy Monitoring:** Provide input to Green City Action Plan update; monitor the progress in completing the initiatives in the Green City Action Plan, Environmental Charter, and Urban Environmental Accords. Lobby for an Environmental Sustainability Coordinator.
6. **Hahamongna Watershed Park Advisory Committee Participation (HWPAC):** Throughout the year, appointees will actively participate in committee meetings and provide updates to the EAC.
7. **Residential Impact Fee:** Review and comment on the annual report on the amount of impact fees collected and how they are expended.
8. **General Plan Open Space & Conservation Element:** Monitor implementation of the sustainability measures in this element.
9. **Education:** Get more information out to the community about sustainability issues.
10. **710 Freeway:** Monitor the draft EIR for the 710 freeway completion and advise the City Council on the environmental impacts of the project and alternatives.
