A. 950 South Raymond Avenue & 1700 Lida Street (Art Center College of Design)

On February 3, 2015, the Design Commission conducted a Preliminary Consultation for a new 10-year Master Plan for Art Center College of Design which comprehensively identifies a vision for both the Hillside and South campuses. The proposed Master Plan focuses growth on the South Campus while making infrastructure upgrades to the Hillside Campus. Art Center has revised their plans to involve more detailed phasing and construction of the South Campus, in response to feedback from the Design Commission, Planning staff, as well as residents of Pasadena and the Art Center community. The purpose of this information item is to present the college's new vision for the Art Center South Campus. The proposed plans for the Hillside Campus remain the same as reviewed by the Commission during the Preliminary Consultation presentation.

5. **ADVISORY REVIEW**

A. 3880 E. Sierra Madre Boulevard (La Salle High School Master Plan)

The proposed project is a 15-year Master Plan for the construction of athletic and performance arts facilities for La Salle High School. The project includes the demolition of two existing buildings, removal of an existing baseball field, renovation and addition to existing buildings, construction of five new buildings, consisting of a classroom building, new practice gym, aquatic building, performance arts and sound stage building and a field house, resulting in a net increase of 83,874 square feet. The project also includes a new outdoor swimming pool with an associated sound wall, reconfiguration of an existing surface parking lot (north parking lot), a new surface parking lot (south parking lot), landscaping and the removal of 14 protected trees. No increase in student enrollment is proposed; the existing permitted enrollment capacity will remain at 780 students. The number of faculty will increase from 90 to 95.




