It is recommended that the Historic Preservation Commission:

- 1. Find that the designation of a historic resource is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15308, Class 8 pertaining to actions by regulatory agencies for the protection of the environment;
- 2. Find that the house at 1587 North Los Robles Avenue meets landmark designation criterion C in Pasadena Municipal Code (P.M.C) Section 17.62.040(C)(2)(c) because it embodies the distinctive characteristics of a locally significant property type, architectural style and period as well as the work of a locally significant architect. The building is a locally significant, intact example of the two-story Arts & Crafts Period House property type, designed by David M. Renton.
- 3. Recommend that the City Council approve the designation of the property at 1587 North Los Robles Avenue as a landmark.

- 1. Find that the proposed project is categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act, §15331 (Class 31, Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation);
- 2. Find that no protected native, specimen, or landmark trees under the tree protection ordinance (Ch.8.52, P.M.C.) will be removed in conjunction with the restoration/rehabilitation;
- 3. Find that upon implementation of the recommended conditions of approval, the proposed application will be consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation; and
- 4. Based on these findings, approve the application, subject to conditions, which shall be reflected on the plans and elevations submitted for building permits and shall be subject to final review and approval by staff.
