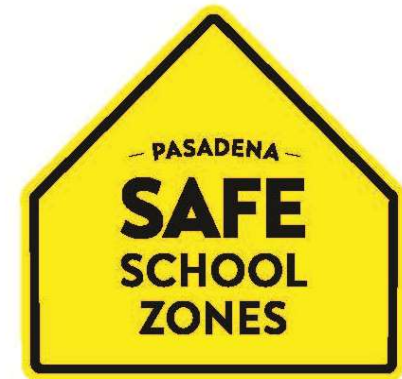
- California Office of Traffic Safety (through NHTSA)
- Awarded \$145,000 in OTS Grant Funds
- Grant Period: October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.
- Provides for:
 - > Expansion of “We Make Time” pedestrian safety campaign
 - > Updating the Suggested Routes to School Maps

- Classroom level pedestrian safety outreach to 3rd grade students, while also addressing parents and motorists who drive through school zones.

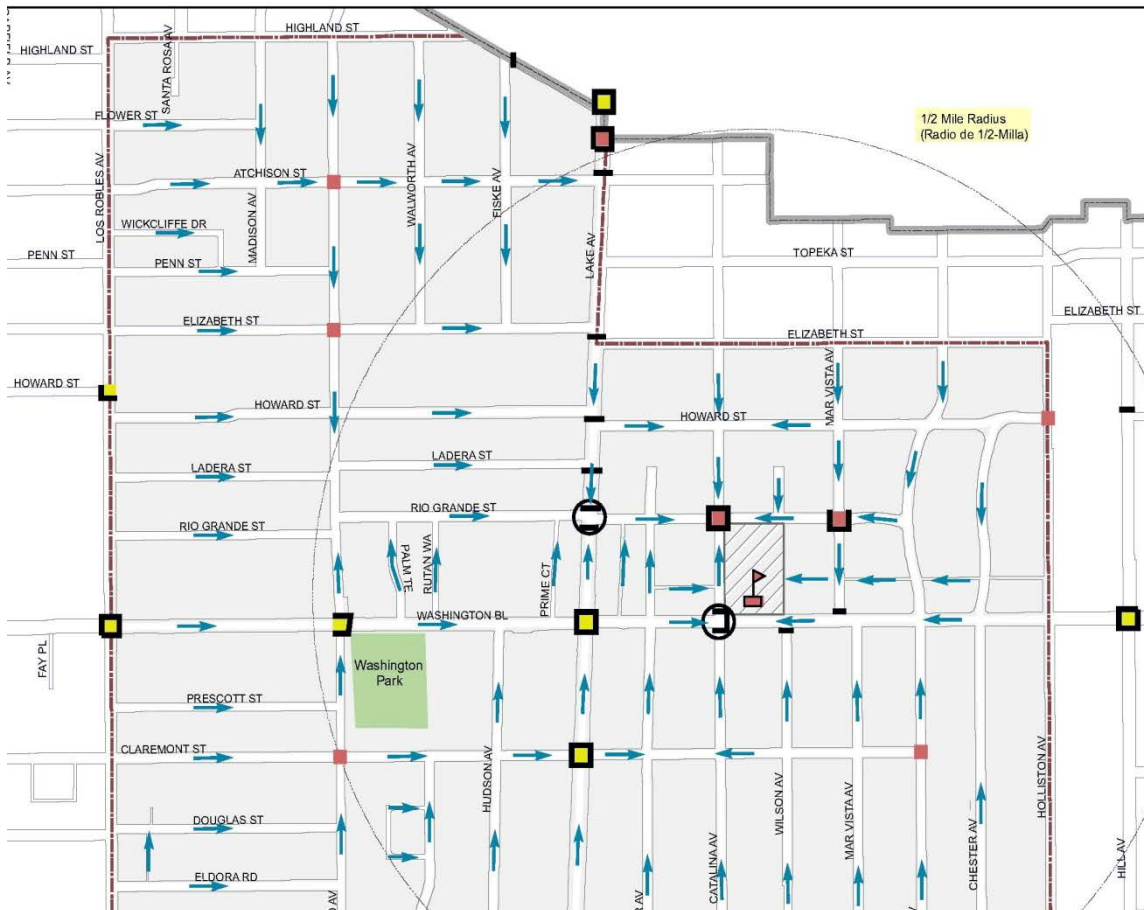

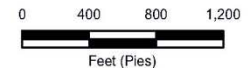
- Updates the Suggested Routes to School Maps for elementary and middle schools in Pasadena.

 - > Submitted in June 2016.
 - > Collaboration of DOT, PUSD, PPH and Day One
 - > Requested \$780,000 of ATP Funding
 - > Safe Routes to School Education and Encouragement Program
 - > 9 Schools (Elementary School through High School)
 - > Years 2019-2021
