

The Pasadena Friendship Community Development Corporation (PF CDC) is a non-profit 501(C) 3 public benefit corporation whose mission statement is to provide affordable housing and services for seniors and families of risk.



One of their main service events is the Annual Community Service Day (CSD) which is held twice a year in April and October. In conjunction with local businesses, volunteers, and neighbors the CSD provides minor repairs, landscaping, trash hauling and other services for homeowners in need in the Pasadena and Altadena areas. Through the wonderful efforts of these volunteers and local the support of local officials, this event has taken the concept of helping thy neighbor to new levels.
