Comments	My name is Lorna Moore, former Transportation Commissioner for Councilmember Steve Madison. In the early 1990's, I succeeded in getting language into the City's first major revision of our General Plan, specifically citing Pasadena and St. John Avenues for traffic calming. The

proposed St. John/Pasadena Avenue Capacity Enhancement is in direct conflict with the General Plan.

The General Plan recognized that, while the 710 Freeway continued it's decades long debate, it was time to undo the effects of the premature freeway spur, to redirect regional traffic to it's historic routes along our city's commercially zoned, freeway-connecting thoroughfares rather than onto tiny Pasadena and St. John Avenues lined with schools, parks and homes.

In the late 1990's, as part of a citizen driven effort, I wrote the project description that then Congressman Rogan submitted to obtain \$28 million in Federal funds to do just that. The city's transportation division used the funds to enhance capacity on the commercial thoroughfares but never implemented the projects to direct the freeway spur traffic to those thoroughfares and deemphasize Pas/St. John Avenues.

A capacity enhancement of the freeway exit and Pas/St. John Avenues directly conflicts with our General Plan and our years of planning and funding.
