Comments	Writing to urge the Pasadena Planning Commission to oppose the 3 proposed CIP projects in item 5A, all of which will increase unsafe conditions for children and families in Pasadena and counteract efforts by the city to create safe streets for all residents.

St John’s Capacity Improvement. Follow the lead of Sequoyah families and oppose this proposed project, which will exacerbate unsafe conditions with a dangerous new dual-turn lane. Additionally, any proposed roadway projects in this area are premature until the planning for the 710 stub is complete, which will determine land uses and circulation patterns.

Walnut Corridor Signalization. As a resident that lives on Walnut Street, I strongly urge commissioners to oppose this project which would worsen the unsafe conditions of this street. Use this funding for safe streets improvements rather than making Walnut “a 210 freeway bypass” as staff report suggests.

ITS. As a resident who fearfully bikes my daughter to school along Green and Orange Grove, which are already dangerous speedways, with nearly all cars speeding well beyond posted limits, I urge opposition to this project.

There are better ways to utilize these funds for safe streets in Pasadena—please reject these speedway projects.
