Hello, Ms. Moran,

My name is Carlene Miller, and I live at 615 Burleigh Drive in Pasadena, on the corner of La Loma Road, just across the street from the proposed construction project at 1065 La Loma Road.

Based on the story poles, which I can see very well from my house, the proposed structure is going to stick out like a sore thumb above the trees between my house and the proposed structure. To build such a large and tall structure on top of a hill seems completely out of character for the neighborhood. Such a large house at a lower elevation might be acceptable -- if substantially set back from the street and sheltered by foliage -- but given the location on top of a hill, it is not acceptable. Are there not height limitations that take into account the elevation of the property?? I strongly urge that the design of the proposed structure be altered to result in a house that does not rise above the substantial height of nearby trees.
