The signs may have helped somewhat on Madison but a permanent solution like speed bumps are needed. And Del Mar needs to be slowed full stop. On Del Mar there are two schools, many residents and pedestrians, but it's set up like a highway with high speeds, few crosswalks, few lights, and no bike lanes.
