Pasadena Municipal Code

2.48.080 - Rules and regulations.

The commission shall adopt and amend, by the affirmative vote of 5 members, rules and regulations for the conduct of the commission's business consistent with this chapter. Such rules and regulations shall be submitted to the city council and shall not become effective until approved and ordered filed by the council.

Accessibility and Disability Commission Rules and Regulations

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENT OF RULES

SECTION 1. These rules may be amended at any regular meeting of the commission by a majority vote, provided that the amendment has been submitted in writing at the previous meeting. Proposed amendments must be submitted to the Board of Directors for final approval.

CITY OF PASADENA ACCESSIBILITY AND DISABILITY COMMISSION WORK PLAN 08/01/20 - 06/30/21

MISSION (as stated in Charter/Ordinance):

The purpose of the commission is to advise the council on accessibility issues in Pasadena. The commission shall:

- 1. Study and examine (a) existing inequities in access to the physical, work, communication, civic involvement, social and cultural environments for all residents of Pasadena, particularly those who have disabilities, and (b) policies, procedures, programs and legislation for eliminating those inequities.
- Recommend policies, procedures, programs and legislation to promote and ensure the accessibility of the physical, work, communication, civic involvement, social and cultural environments to all residents of Pasadena, particularly those who have disabilities.
- 3. Consult and cooperate with other public agencies and commissions on matters relevant to the commission.
- 4. Assist the accessibility and disability issues coordinator to carry out assigned programs and responsibilities.

OBJECTIVES:

1. OUTREACH

Objective: To increase awareness and visibility of the Accessibility & Disability Commission, gather information about concerns of persons with disabilities in Pasadena, promote leadership and citizenship opportunities for persons with disabilities, and build working partnerships with local business, academic, nonprofit, and civic organizations.

- If permissible under COVID-19 guidelines, table at a minimum of four community events, and update, print, and distribute brochures about the Accessibility and Disability Commission in print and digital formats.
