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I reside at 840 E Green, less than 50 feet from the project.

I note construction/demolition hours for a 2 ½ year period, from June 2023 – December 2025, 6 days per week; M-F 7 AM-7PM, Saturday 8AM – 5 PM. That is approximately 783 days of totally disruptive noise!

The sound study assessing existing noise was done the morning of Sept 17, 2019. Four locations, average 15 minutes each. Quite a body of data to determine that noise imposed on me for 2 ½ years, 9,000 hours, 6 days / week, will be “...less than significant impact’ per initial review.

My observations over smaller local projects , show that equipment, trucks and cars turn up as much as 1-2 before the allowed starting time, parking anywhere they please, with engines left to idle, safety back up beeping, unloading, shouting. Equipment you listed as tractors, loaders, backhoes, welders, pavers, rollers, compressors, etc.

Can you unambiguously state that no vehicles can arrive at or near the site, and equipment already on site will not idle, before and after the stated time?
