<b>Comments</b>	The proposed project has major negative impacts on the biological and recreational resources in the Arroyo Seco and in Hahamongna Watershed Park. These impacts can be reduced or eliminated by leaving the stream flow in the stream. But PWP falsely insists that it would be too lengthy and difficult to renegotiate the Raymond Basin Judgement to grant Pasadena credits for water left in the stream, even though the agreement has already been renegotiated twice, in 1955 and 2009, since it was originally created in 1944. It is unreasonable and harmful to cause so many impacts when renegotiation is actually a valid option to avoid the harm.
