SUBJECT: Transportation Advisory Commissioners Goals for the 2021-2022 Work Plan

The City's Municipal Code, section 2.135.090 requires that the Transportation Advisory Commission (TAC) submit an annual report and work plan to be presented to city council by September 1st of each year. In preparation for the development of the FY 2022 TAC Work Plan, at the May 27, 2021 meeting of the TAC, Chair Sam Morrissey asked that each commissioner submit up to three goals that would help guide and inform the development of the Work Plan.

As the Work Plan is intended to guide the work of the TAC, it is best that the identified priorities be high level, providing sufficient clarity on policy priorities but allowing for some flexibility. After reviewing the goals submitted, they were synthesized into overarching themes. The following list is submitted for your consideration:

- Increase communication/role of commissioners as liaisons;
- Support policies that advance place making;
- Provide feedback and monitor projects of city-wide significance;
- Monitor impacts and benefits of city adopted CEQA (Vehicle Miles Travelled and Vehicle Trips) and Local Mobility Analysis Guidelines;
- Support policies and programs that advance safer streets for all, reduce fatalities, improve mobility;
- Support efforts that enhance the transit riding experience; and
- Support efforts and policies that advance the implementation of the Bicycle Transportation Action Plan.

It is recommended that the TAC review and discuss the submitted goals as part of the FY 2022 Work Plan development process.
