RE: Agenda Item No. 5 – Consideration of Further Training Opportunities for Commission and Direction to Staff to Begin Process of Securing Specific Training

Recommendation

This report is for information only.

The following information is intended to provide further details on potential training opportunities the Community Police Oversight Commission could request, and the process for staff to assist in planning and scheduling said trainings. Staff recommends that the Community Police Oversight Commission discuss these or any other training opportunities they see fit, and request staff to begin the process of organizing appropriate trainings for the Commission.

Background

Each member of the Community Police Oversight Commission received at least 30 hours of training facilitated by the Police Department (which included modules from the Independent Police Auditor and the City Attorney's Office) in subject matters related to Commissioners' role on the Commission.

Members of the Commission and the community at large have expressed a desire for Commission members to receive additional training on topics that would further support the work of the Commission and inform their decision-making and recommendations. The Commission should discuss the training opportunities discussed in this Agenda Report (as well as any other opportunities), and provide direction to staff to begin the process of researching, prioritizing, and organizing appropriate trainings for Commission meetings.

Discussion

While there are quite likely numerous trainings that would benefit the Commission, staff suggests the Commission consider the following topics, among others:

- Trauma informed care
- Cultural sensitivity
- Anti-racism
- Understanding of Pasadena's history, with a focus on our rich immigrant history

If the Commission is interested in receiving any of these or other trainings, the appropriate process would be to request staff to assist in researching, prioritizing, and organizing trainings for the Commission. While the Commission does not currently have a budget for training, staff can investigate the possibility of trainings that are free of cost through community partnerships and other avenues. If there are training opportunities desired which have a cost associated with them, staff can research such possibilities and return to the Commission with options and recommendations.

If there are other areas within Pasadena Police Department operations that would be valuable for the Commission to learn more about, staff could also facilitate these internal trainings and conversations.
