Hello, I'm submitting my comments about 72 N Fair Oaks, Der Wolf, in advance of the CUP revocation hearing today. Attached is a video clip that I sent to Lt. Sean Dawkins in October. It's a prime example of the noise we've been subjected to by Der Wolf (and occasionally the Old Towne Pub) for more than 18 months—loud music at all hours of the night, screaming & cheering patrons, drunk people spilling into the streets, motorcycles blasting along Holly and in/out of the alleyway behind the bar. The disturbances occur most nights except Mondays, but are especially bad on the weekends—including Sunday nights. Over the past year and half we've called the police to report loud music coming from the bar no less than twice a week. It should be noted that we live across the street behind double-paned glass, and even when the police respond and the music level is reduced, we can STILL hear it in our home. The problem has also become dramatically worse since the owners have been allowed to operate outside in the central courtyard. We've had enough. We need for this to stop and stop NOW. We're tax paying citizens and deserve to live in this neighborhood in peace, without the threat of a rogue bar disturbing us with loud music, unruly patrons and blasting motorcycles.
