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Many my neighbors and myself are horrified by the signs posted around this property that it will be torn down, along with protected trees, to build a 4 story building. I live on the east side of our complex at [REDACTED], and purchased my particular unit because it faced a one story building (which was not visible to us) and which included several beautiful tall trees. What is the point of having protected trees that will not be protected? Plus, we once had the view of the nearby mountains, which we no longer have.

The noise and dust of this plan has really upset many of us and especially the 100 or more of us who live on the east side of our complex.

This area has been over built. We keep hearing that Pasadena needs more housing... yet when I drive to the east side of the city there are large **swaths of undeveloped land** ... yet around Old Town there are many new glass modern buildings that do NOT fit the look that makes Old Town... Old Town.

There seems to be nothing we can do but endure the noise and debris and lose our view and privacy. But I would like an answer as to why are exceptions being made for this property when there are so many of places where height and size wouldn't upset the neighborhood?
