People were smoking and putting out their cigarettes on the dry grass, also, a fire hazard. Vagrants used her hillside for overnight stays including defecating .

Ms. Majcher has enriched her hillside with beautiful trees and plants and flowers. These additions bring beauty to the whole area and neighborhood. Her property borders La Canada and Flintridge Sacred Heart Schools. A fire would be a devastation for the whole Pasadena community surrounding her home. Ms. Majcher lives there alone with her two minor children. She is an integral member of Pasadena giving many gatherings at this home which promote social and well-fare causes. She, her children, her home, her land and the people who participate in her life must feel safe in her surroundings. This is HER home and no one should be interrupting her ongoing efforts to maintain and provide her safety with this gate. Most homes have protective enclosures featuring even more than a gate. The fire department and the police have access to this gate through a standard "Knox Box". No one and nothing will be harmed by keeping this gate in place. This gate is her right and more importantly her necessity. The only opinion needed is one that reassures her personal safety and peace of mind. Marley has done everything the city has requested of her. It is now the city's responsibility to protect her wishes and needs for safety and privacy.
