I would like to submit for consideration at the hearing the below items that have been witnessed, documented, and evidenced that bring to question the standards by which this development was built:

- Submission by the soils engineer of falsified soil compaction tests along the boundary with 595 Lincoln following and related to the wall that fell over during construction due to the absence of shoring by the contractor
- Moving of the boundary markers by the general contractor in order to influence the city officials regarding ownership of the wall and therefore responsibility to remediate
- Absence of an I-Beam that should have been in place

The above are a few of the indications that this development was not built to appropriate standards.
