IPA ACTIVITIES – SEPTEMBER 2023

- CPOC Ad Hoc Subcommittee meetings
 - *Providing support and direction for Ad Hoc Subcommittees relating to:*
 - Review of PPD pretext stops policies and practices
 - Consideration of a community-police mediation program
 - Public reporting on previous recommendations made by OIR Group, NPF and IPA
 - PPD use of technology
 - Community Engagement

IPA ACTIVITIES – SEPTEMBER 2023

- Reduction of backlog on Officer-Involved Shooting Administrative Investigations & Reviews.
 - **May 17, 2019, fatal shooting of Daniel Warren:** *DA letter received May 25, 2023; set for Use of Force Review Board on October 11.*
 - **May 8, 2020, fatal shooting of Lloyd Nelson Jr.:** *DA Letter received July 5, 2023; Administrative investigation in progress and to be completed late November / early December.*
 - **November 23, 2021, fatal shooting of Devon Hall:** *Administrative Investigation to start effective immediately.*
 - **July 3, 2022, fatal shooting of Adam Youines:** *tolled pending DA adjudication – status of administrative investigation to be discussed upon conclusion of other administrative investigations and reviews.*

IPA ACTIVITIES – SEPTEMBER 2023

- **Body Worn Camera Policy:**
 - IPA submitted model policies to PPD Command Staff for consideration.
 - PPD to discuss potential changes with union and report back on any changes by mid-November.
 - Goal is to ensure more consistent activation and deactivation of BWC's throughout the department through policy, training, supervision and discipline.
- Continued monitoring of UOFRB and Disciplinary Review Board meetings.

IPA ACTIVITIES – SEPTEMBER 2023

- Preparing for review of all Internal Affairs cases closed between October 2022 and October 2023.
 - Public Assessment report to be completed by Spring 2024 to include:
 - Quality of overall process for handling community complaints.
 - Quality of investigations.
 - Timeliness of investigations.
 - Reasonableness of findings
 - Adequacy and fairness of discipline
- Creation of methodology for outside expert review of PPD Early Warning System
