IPA ACTIVITIES – NOVEMBER 2023

- CPOC Ad Hoc Subcommittee Support
 - Completion of a draft methodology for CPOC review of “pretext” traffic stops to be discussed at Dec. 7, 2023 meeting.
 - Facilitation of Pretext Stop Literature Review to be completed mid-December, 2023.
 - Drafting of proposed mediation protocols, submitted to PPD for review and comment.
 - Continued work on draft Discipline Advisory Group Terms of Reference for review and comment by IPA Collaboration Ad Hoc Committee.

IPA ACTIVITIES – NOVEMBER 2023

- **Body Worn Camera Policy**
 - PPD is continuing to work on policy changes – additional conferral with police union required.
 - PPD to report back before end of December 2023 with IPA to provide feedback to CPOC.
- **OIS investigation review & reporting**
 - May 17, 2019, fatal shooting of Daniel Warren.
 - IPA review of case file and PPD UOFRB findings completed.
 - IPA public report to be completed and published before the end of December, 2023.

IPA ACTIVITIES – CURRENT & PENDING SPRING, 2024

- Review of all Internal Affairs cases closed in 2022 and 2023 (131 to date).
- More than one half of 2023 case reviews completed to date.
- Public Assessment report scheduled to be completed by end of Spring 2024 to include:
 - Quality of overall process for handling community complaints.
 - Quality of investigations.
 - Timeliness of investigations.
 - Reasonableness of findings
 - Adequacy and fairness of discipline

DECEMBER SITE VISIT

- IPA “site visit” scheduled for December 12 & 13, 2023
 - Primary purpose: to monitor and assess PPD Firearms & Crowd Control Training.
 - Secondary purpose: to meeting with community members based upon prior requests.
- More extensive visit with primary purposes of community engagement and meeting with police and city leadership anticipated for February 2024.
