I hope this email finds you well. As a resident at [REDACTED], I would like to strongly oppose the safe parking program at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church. While I appreciate the city's attempt to address the homelessness issue, I have already noticed an increase in transient problems at my building as a result of the bad weather shelter opening and our close proximity to Salvation Army. Just the other day, a homeless male tried opening my neighbor's unit several times before the police were able to arrive and remove him from the premises. It's apparent our community is already facing safety issues, and I'm concerned this may increase if the program is permitted. Please help keep me and my neighbors safe.
