Dear Ms. Walker,

I am writing to express my concerns and disagreement over the request to allow Safe Parking at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church.

I live at [REDACTED], the ground floor facing Walnut, and have experienced firsthand the disruption this community has created daily in front of my home. There are days and nights of endless screaming, people on the streets behaving erratically, cussing, screaming, sleeping, trespassing, and vandalizing my property throughout the five years I have lived here, and the issues have gotten exponentially worse in the last year.

Waking my dog has become an issue in the neighborhood for fear of what might happen. There are pods of intoxicated, strung-out humans on every corner, human excrement on our property, trash, clothes, and all kinds of waste strewn about the area. This chaos continues onto Locust Street, Mentor, and Walnut - walking anywhere around here is no longer safe. Our property value will never be what it could have been due to this new Salvation Army Housing Center 1 block away.

We must find an alternate location to support and rehabilitate the unhoused population, and it can not be in a residential neighborhood. It is unhealthy, unsafe, and fraught with fear.

Please do not continue this- it is terrible for Pasadena and this neighborhood!
