

Congratulations to the Community Police Oversight Commission. I look forward to the CPOC helping the Pasadena community thrive.

Here is a list of law-enforcement legislation that was signed into law in 2021 that the commission should include in your 2021-2022 work plan:

SB 2¹: Peace officers: certification: civil rights

Establishes a decertification procedure for peace officers and the removal/denial of qualified immunity for claims or actions brought under Tom Bane Civil Rights Act (Civil Code section 52.1). It reduces immunity provisions for officers to enable victims of police violence to pursue wrongful death and other civil rights claims in state court.

SB 16²: Peace officers: release of records

Building on SB 1421, SB 16 expands the types of police records that must be disclosed, adding four categories to the four existing disclosure mandates.

AB 26³: Peace officers: use of force

Establishes responsibilities and outlines steps officers must take when witnessing excessive force by a fellow law enforcement officer. Furthermore, an officer who fails to intervene will receive the same discipline as the officer who uses excessive force. This bill also prohibits agencies from retaliating against the reporting officer.

AB 48⁴: Law enforcement: use of force

Establishes clear, minimum statewide standards on law enforcement's use of rubber bullets and tear gas for crowd control.

AB 89⁵: Peace officers: minimum qualifications

increases the qualifying age for peace officers from 18 to 21.

AB 481⁶: Law enforcement & state agencies: military equipment: funding, acquisition & use

Regulates the funding, acquisition, and use of military equipment by law enforcement and state agencies.

AB 490⁷: Law enforcement agency policies: arrests: positional asphyxia

Focuses on use of force, but specifically positional asphyxia. Existing law prohibits any law enforcement agency from authorizing the use of a carotid restraint or a chokehold, and this bill now also prohibits authorizing techniques or transport methods that involve a substantial risk of positional asphyxia.

AB 958⁸: Peace officers: law enforcement gangs

Defines the term "law enforcement gang" and requires law enforcement agencies to terminate any officer who participates in one.

AB 481: Law enforcement & state agencies: military equipment: funding, acquisition & use.

Requires **use policies & impact statements** for controlled equipment:

Equipment	AB 481
Armored vehicles, <i>excluding police versions of standard consumer vehicles</i>	"Mine-resistant ambush-protected (MRAP) vehicles or armored personnel carriers"
Unmanned vehicles	"Unmanned, remotely piloted, powered aerial or ground vehicles"
Tracked armored vehicles	"Tracked armored vehicles that provide ballistic protection to their occupants and utilize a tracked system instead of wheels for forward motion"
Assault rifles / patrol rifles	"Specialized firearms and ammunition of less than .50 caliber, including assault weapons as defined in Sections 30510 and 30515 of the Penal Code, with the exception of standard issue service weapons and ammunition of less than .50 caliber that are issued to officers, agents, or employees of a law enforcement agency or a state agency"
Projectile launch platforms	"Following projectile launch platforms and their associated munitions: 40mm projectile launchers, "bean bag," rubber bullet, and specialty impact munition (SIM) weapons"
Breaching apparatus	"Battering rams, slugs, and breaching apparatuses that are explosive in nature." <i>Excludes bolt cutters, one-person handheld ram.</i>
HMMWV-type vehicles	"Humvees, two and one-half-ton trucks, five-ton trucks, or wheeled vehicles that have a breaching or entry apparatus attached" <i>Excludes ATVs and motorized dirt bikes</i>
Command and control vehicles	"Command and control vehicles that are either built or modified to facilitate the operational control and direction of public safety units"
.50 caliber weapons	Firearms and ammunition of .50 caliber or greater. <i>Excludes "standard-issue shotguns"</i>
Electronic weapons / devices	"Taser Shockwave, microwave weapons, water cannons, and the Long Range Acoustic Device (LRAD)"
Flashbangs, tear gas, pepper balls	"Flashbang' grenades and explosive breaching tools, 'tear gas,' and 'pepper balls'" <i>Excludes handheld pepper spray"</i>
Explosive projectile launchers	"Any firearm or firearm accessory that is designed to launch explosive projectiles"
