Those who attend will have the opportunity to enter a lottery for two free Arroyo Seco Weekend concert tickets.

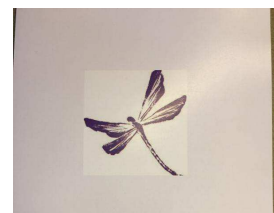

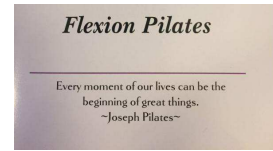

710 Tunnel

The tunnel issue is dead. On May 25th, Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) Board voted unanimously against the tunnel and allocated the remaining money to help local cities deal with traffic.

According to Metro staff, approximately \$730 million remains in the SR-710 fund of which \$105 million has been allocated to implement the projects listed in the Environmental Impact Report namely Transportation System

Management and Transportation Demand Management (TSM/TDM). The remainder of the money will be made available for new projects in corridor communities, which will be developed collaboratively with Metro.

Illegal Businesses

City Council recently passed an ordinance that gives the City the right to cut off water and power to problem locations that have on-going non-compliant land use issues. Marijuana dispensaries would fall under this category but the language covers any use that is non-compliant. City staff is working on the details to make it happen and we expect it to be able to use this tool by the end of the month.
