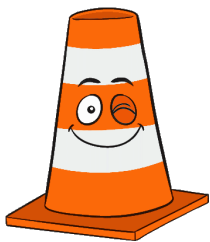

Dynamic Message Signs – Installation on the intersections of Orange Grove and Lake, Hill and Allen – Ongoing project

Orange Grove Resurfacing – Completing striping/manhole

adjustment in December 2020.

New Curb Ramps – Villa/Linda Rosa & Villa/Oak – January/Feb 2021

Sewer Repair 2021 – Clean & reline sewer mains: Loma Vista between Hill & Sierra Bonita; Woodlyn between Craig & Martelo – January/Feb 2021

Palo Verde Transmission Line – transmission line installation along Palo Verde – through end of January 2021

PUBLIC SAFETY CORNER

Safety Tips:

Package Theft – Help prevent theft by doing the following:

- Track your package or schedule a delivery time.
- Require a signature.
- Hold package at mail facility or use Amazon locker.
- Coordinate with neighbors to hold or keep an eye out for packages.



Holiday Decorating Fires – Help prevent fires by doing the following:

- Be sure to water real trees every day because dry needles and wood catch fire more easily.
- Follow the manufacturer recommendations on number of light strings that can be connected to each other.
- Discard light strings that are worn or broken.
- Always unplug the lights before leaving the house or going to sleep, or use a timer.
- Use battery operated candles and refrain from using any type of open flame device.
- Trees should be placed at a safe distance away from fireplaces.
