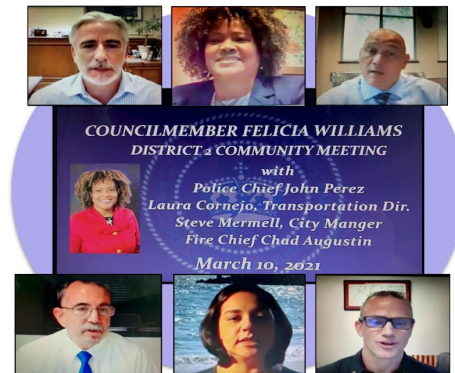

Pasadena Public Health Department reports that:

- 51.2% of Pasadenans have received at least one dose of the COVID vaccine.
- 30.5% of Pasadenans are fully vaccinated.
- Everyone 50 and over is now eligible to receive the vaccine.
- Those 16 and over will be eligible on April 15th.

EVENTS

This year the **31st Annual Bungalow Heaven Home Tour** has been reimagined: **As Seen Through a Lens from April 22 - 28**. Docents will lead a video walk-through of seven historic homes, providing insightful commentary about the home's architectural details and history. Separate

videos will include artisans demonstrating their talents in restoration and sharing tips and tricks of their trade. A reservation-only Zoom Q & A with California bungalow historians will be held during the Home Tour to provide an opportunity to learn more about our featured homes. Did you know that:

- More than 200 dozen homemade cookies are baked by the neighbors each year for the home tour.
- In 2019, they assembled 160 volunteers plus 30 cookie bakers.
- There are a dozen people/couples who have paid to come to the tour at least 20 times. The most recorded visits stands at 26!
- Over 200 homes have been part of the home tour during the past 31 years.
- 2020 was their first year to not hold the home tour since it's beginning in 1989, ending a streak of 30 years straight.
- Bungalow Heaven has been featured in numerous publications: USA Today, Los Angeles Times, Pasadena Star News, Pasadena Weekly, Pasadena Now, American Bungalow, Old House Journal, Cottages and Bungalows, and numerous books about Arts & Crafts Bungalows and Pasadena.

Mills Act Applications Due May 17

The City of Pasadena Historic Property Contract Program was established in October 2002 under the authority of a State enabled program known as the Mills Act. Under this act, local governments may enter into contracts with owners of qualifying privately-owned historic properties who agree to rehabilitate, restore and/or maintain their property in exchange for a reduction in property taxes. YOUR VOICE AT CITY HALL

Over the next few months the City Council will be looking at the following key items:

- **Police Oversight Commission** - selection process for members representing community organizations at Public Safety Committee on April 7 and appointment of full Commission by Council on April 19. *Thank you to*

the 13 applicants from District 2! The selection process is underway.




- **Climate Action Plan** - 2019 annual report on the City's greenhouse gas reduction efforts.
- **Plastic Utensils by Request Only** - proposed ordinance for restaurants to provide plastic utensils only on request for take-out orders.
- **City Cannabis Ordinance** - review and possible update to Measure CC ordinance approved by voters in 2018.
- **Redistricting Commission** - selection of members on April 12. *Thank you to the applicants from District 2! The selection process is underway.*
- **Water System & Resources Plan** - review of draft 25-year plan for our water system on April 26.
- **Traffic Analysis** - review of Local Mobility Analysis ("Outside CEQA") thresholds and process to determine impact on traffic flow from new development.
- **Operating Budget** - overview of proposed fiscal year 2021-22 budget and capital improvement plan on May 17.
- **Housing Element update** - The Planning Department will be holding two virtual community workshops in April, find more information [here](#).



TRASH TALK

Have you every wondered what items are recyclable? How to schedule a Bulky Item pick up? How to dispose of your hazardous waste? Here are a few tips from Pasadena Public Works!

- **Bulky item pick-up services** are offered only to City of Pasadena Refuse customers. A customer may schedule two free bulky item pickups per year by calling **626-744-7311** or using the **Citizen Service app**. Please note that bulky items are subject to scheduling availability. Typical bulky items include furniture and mattresses. Click [here](#) for more information.
- **Disposal of Hazardous Materials** - DO NOT place hazardous material like electronics, paint, batteries, aerosols, pesticides, or vehicle fluids in your trash, recycling, or yard waste container. At Villa Parke Farmers Market on Tuesday you can participate in a "market match" program - when you use EBT funds for purchases the market will match up to \$10 per market day of your funds. This means you get extra buying power for fresh fruits and vegetables!
