### MAKE CONNECTIONS. LEARN TO LEAD.

The University of California Summer Institute for Emerging Managers and Leaders is an all-expenses paid, career-building fellowship that provides intensive two-week training to first- and second-year students from Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSI).

As a participant in the program, you'll learn from world-class educators at the University of California's graduate business schools. Meet one-on-one with CEOs, CFOs and other industry leaders in some of the country's top hubs for enterprise and innovation. You'll participate in dynamic, hands-on workshops that will immerse you in principles of business development and entrepreneurship and help build analytical, technical and management expertise. You'll gain opportunities for internships, for career development and for continuing on to pursue a master's degree in business.

### WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- First-year students who are currently enrolled at an HBCU or an HSI.
- Students from any major who have an interest in business may apply.
- Students should have demonstrated leadership skills.
- Students must be citizens or permanent residents of the United States.

**The selection process is competitive; the application provides additional criteria.**

**Cost:** The Summer Institute is an **all-expense-paid fellowship** that includes airfare; room and board at campus dormitories; transportation; and related materials, events and entertainment. There is no cost to apply.

**Program Dates:** Students attend for two weeks a year, for two consecutive years. **The 2015 session is slated to run from August 2 through August 14.** Students who complete both sessions are issued Certificates of Completion that can be cited on their resumes or provided as evidence of marketable skills.

**This year's program will be at the University of California, San Diego in partnership with the Rady School of Management.** The University of California, San Diego is one of the top-ranked public research universities in the nation.
