ELIGIBILITY:

Students must;

- Be a high school senior receiving a diploma at the culmination of the 2019/20 academic school year.
- Possess a cumulative grade point average of **2.50 or higher**.
- Reside and/or attend high school within the boundaries of the San Gabriel Valley Chapter which encompasses the City of Burbank east to the Inland Empire.
- Be accepted to an accredited college or university and committed to attend during the 2020/21 academic year.
- ***Complete and submit the following by Friday, April 10, 2020***
 - An Application Form
 - A **450-word essay** authored by the applicant related to the requested scholarship.
 - Unofficial School Transcripts
 - Proof of acceptance to accredited college or university
 - Two Letters of Recommendation (school and community organization)

NOTIFICATION OF APPLICANTS

All recipients will be notified by email in April.

AWARD PAYMENT

Confirmation of school registration is required *prior* to disbursement of scholarship award. Award disbursements will commence July 27, 2020 as follows;
