CITY OF PASADENA HEALTH OFFICER ORDER FOR THE CONTROL OF COVID-19

THIRD SUPPLEMENT TO REVISED – SAFER AT HOME ORDER FOR CONTROL OF COVID-19 ISSUED ON MARCH 22, 2020, AND SUPPLEMENTS ISSUED APRIL 11 AND MAY 15, 2020

This Order Issued: May 26, 2020

This Order is in effect until rescinded in writing by the Health Officer.

Please read this Order carefully. Violation of or failure to comply with this Revised Order is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both. (California Health and Safety Code §120295.)

SUMMARY OF THE ORDER: California is in a State of Emergency because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a substantial danger to the health of the public within the City of Pasadena. COVID-19 can easily spread between people who are in close contact with one another. Everyone is at risk for becoming ill with COVID-19, but some people are more vulnerable to serious illness, including pneumonia and organ failure, or death, due to their age, physical state, and/or health status.

The City of Pasadena Health Officer (“Health Officer”) has issued a number of Orders to help slow COVID-19’s spread, protect vulnerable individuals, and prevent the healthcare system in the City of Pasadena from being overwhelmed. The Revised Safer at Home Orders, dated March 22, 2020 and supplemented April 11 and May 15, 2020, issued by the Health Officer, as well as other “Safer at Home” orders issued by other jurisdictions have been proven to slow the spread of COVID-19.

This order is a limited and measured step to allow the limited re-opening of places of worship for religious services, retail stores, and office-based businesses, following guidance issued by the California Department of Public Health and City of Pasadena.

This Order is issued by the Health Officer through the authority of the Governor’s May 4, 2020 Executive Order N-60-20, which directed the State Public Health Officer to establish criteria for local health officers to implement the re-opening of businesses and spaces. Pasadena is a local health department with a local health officer, and may therefore implement re-openings as mentioned by the Governor, where appropriate.

Grand Opening - Pasadena Installs Largest EV Public Fast Charging Station in the Nation

PASADENA, Calif. — The City of Pasadena is pleased to announce the opening of the Marengo Charging Plaza – 155 E. Green Street. With a total of 44 chargers, 24 Superchargers installed by Tesla and 20 fast chargers installed by the City of Pasadena, the Marengo Charging Plaza is the largest public electric vehicle (EV) fast-charging plaza in the nation. Since the City launched the **PowerUp Pasadena** campaign in 2018, Pasadena has offered some of the most generous rebates to purchase/lease new or used-EVs throughout the state. The City's utility, Pasadena Water and Power (PWP) has more than doubled the installation of public EV charging infrastructure within the City in the past year and half, and received the distinction of having the highest percentage of EV drivers among all southern California electric utilities. The fast-chargers make it possible for EV drivers to charge up and add up to 100 miles in less than 30 minutes. Within its first months of operation the Plaza captured more than 7,000 charging sessions per month.
