A MESSAGE FROM DISTRICT 6 COUNCILMEMBER STEVE MADISON

District 6 Constituents,

We saw across the country a strong and often violent response to the death of George Floyd who died after being pinned down by an officer in the Minneapolis police department. Many weekend protest marches sadly ended up in violence and destruction in many communities. In Pasadena, an attempt at looting was quelled by the PPD. In response to concerns for the safety and welfare of our residents and business community, the City Manager issued a curfew notice in Pasadena which was followed by a county-wide curfew for an earlier time.

The City Council and staff are working with community leaders including residents. Representatives from organizations, and the clergy for important dialogues to bring about a peaceful process for meaningful change.

Today the LA County has issued a county-wide curfew for this evening that will begin at 6 p.m. Pasadena's order will follow the same hours.

City Of Pasadena Statement Regarding Curfew Order

Curfew from 6 p.m. June 1 through 6 a.m. June 2

In accordance with Los Angeles County's Order, the City of Pasadena is implementing another curfew from 6 p.m. June 1 through 6 a.m. June 2. No person should be in any public area unless they are emergency workers with identification or essential workers traveling to or from work. Any person found outside after the curfew is subject to citation or arrest by the Pasadena Police Department and Prosecution by the Pasadena City Prosecutor's Office. The City appreciates your patience and understanding as we take proactive measures to protect our community from the devastation and peril taking place in neighboring cities.
