

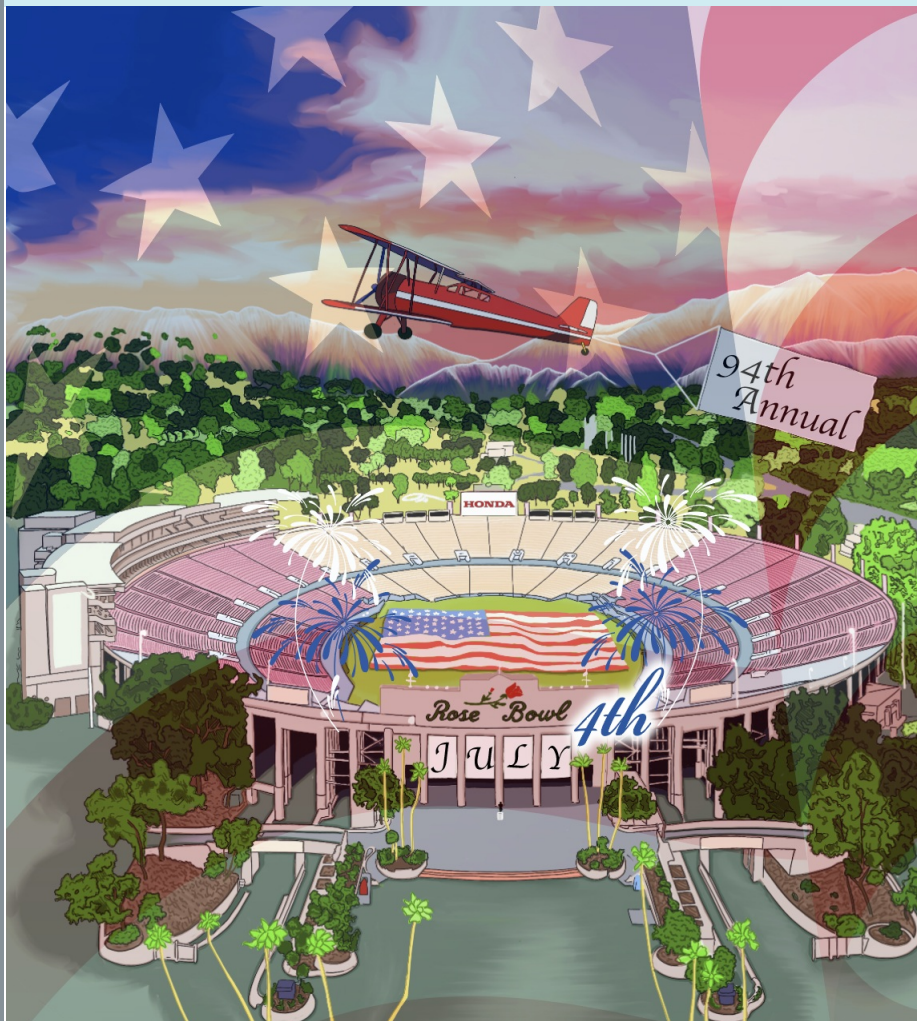


## A MESSAGE FROM DISTRICT 6 COUNCILMEMBER STEVE MADISON

### 94th Annual Virtual AmericaFest

The Rose Bowl Stadium is excited to announce that due to COVID-19 we are transitioning to a virtual event on the afternoon of Saturday, July 4th so Pasadena locals and international fans alike can tune in to the 94th Virtual AmericaFest on [Rose Bowl LIVE](#).

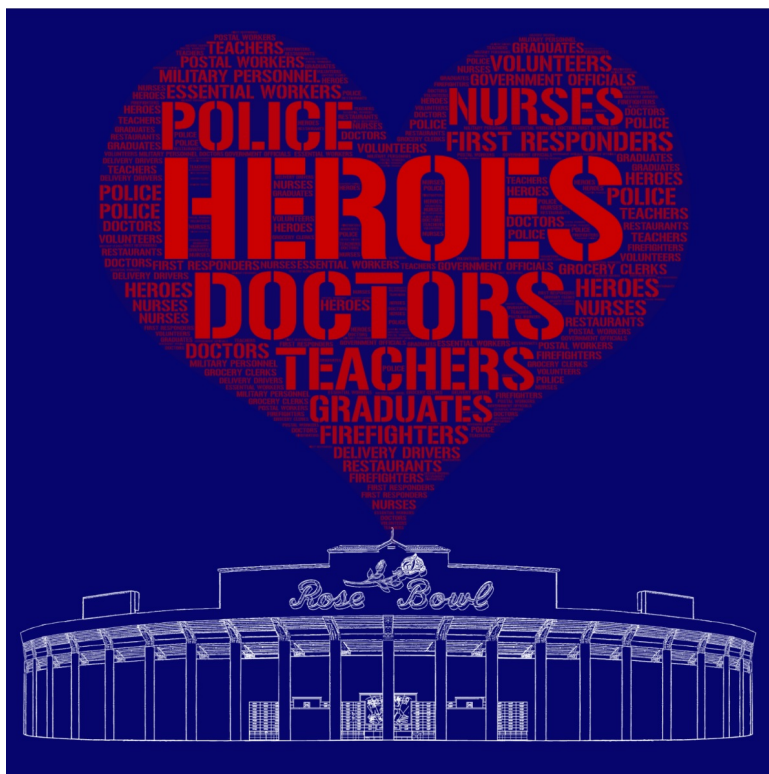
The virtual event held on the stadium's social media channels will include music from cello artist, Cecilia Tsan from the 100-inch telescope dome on top of Mt. Wilson in honor of our United States Fallen Heroes, first responders and frontline workers for their admirable work and courage during COVID-19. In addition, Mt. Wilson has been testing a special art installation called "Sunstar", created and owned by artist Liliane Lijn and astrophysicist John Vallerga. The prism will be moving throughout the day to shine a bit of pure color from the sun over Pasadena.

Focused around legacy and community-building, the one hour virtual event will feature celebrations of our United States Veterans and military personnel, messages from our community thanking first responders, frontline workers and their personal heroes for their work during COVID-19, as well as a salute to America with a message for why we

celebrate the 4th of July. At the culmination of the online-based event, there will be a flyover of Pasadena and its most historic landmarks. The flyover will be viewable from many Pasadena resident's homes, as well as streamed online, providing equal access to this free event for all.

## The Tribeca Drive-In at the Rose Bowl

The Rose Bowl Stadium is excited to announce that Tribeca Enterprises will be hosting "The Tribeca Drive-In" in our parking lots beginning July 2<sup>nd</sup> until July 26<sup>th</sup>. These drive-in movies will run Thursdays through Sunday and tickets can be purchased at [TribecaFilm.com](https://tribecafilm.com) with a percentage of proceeds donated to Black Lives Matter. The events will offer complimentary access and reserved parking to essential workers the first night at every venue. For the official Tribeca announcement, please see below:

Tribeca Enterprises announced 30 films and performances for its annual [Tribeca Drive-In](#) series that will be going national this year with partners AT&T and Imax, with help from the [NFL](#) to expand the event to stadiums in Dallas, Miami and Seattle.

The Tribeca Drive-In has been a signature feature of the [Tribeca Film Festival](#) for 20 years and, this year, the movie form is having a renaissance due to the coronavirus. So while the festival migrated online in 2020, the drive-in grew. It will run from July 2 to August 2, Thursdays through Sunday. Other venues include AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas; Nickerson Beach in Nassau County, NY; and Orchard Beach in the Bronx, NY. More will be announced in coming weeks.

The lineup includes music-themed movies *Selena*, *The Bodyguard*, *Straight Outta Compton*; Sports Sundays with *Creed*, *Jerry Maguire*, *Space Jam*, and *Love and Basketball*; Time travel comedies with *Bill & Ted's Excellent Adventure* and *Back to the Future*; high school comedies with *Mean Girls* and *Superbad*; Ladies' Night with *Girls Trip* and *Bridesmaids*, 'hit the road' pics *Talladega Nights* and *The Fast And The Furious*; a James Bond tribute with *Goldfinger* and *Casino Royale*; and kids' night with *Inside Out*, *The Lego Movie*, and *Spy Kids*. July 4<sup>th</sup> will feature *Field of Dreams*, *The Wizard of Oz*, and a special 25th Anniversary screening of *Apollo 13*.
